EVENT DESCRIPTION

The event will be a State Championship Race Meeting held over two days. (Friday 16th June, 2017 will be a Private Practice activity run by the Benalla Auto Club). The activities will be conducted at Winton Motor Raceway and cars will circulate in a clockwise direction of the 3.0 km National Circuit. (Long Circuit)

ENTRIES

The preferred method of entry is via CAMS Event Entry-www.meecamsau.com Those using it know how easy it is. For all others, we strongly encourage you to use this time saving system. There is a tutorial on the website for first timers and a telephone help number for use during business hours.

Mail entries must be posted to the Entry Secretary at PO Box 226, Point Lonsdale, Vic, 3225

Entries will open on Monday 10th April and close on Wednesday 7th June 2017. Competitors are reminded of clause 83 of the NCR's of the CAMS Manual of Motorsport regarding refusal of entries.
until the The entry fee will be **\$400.00 (GST Inc)** for entries received up to **Monday 23rd MAY, 2017** and **\$430.00(GST inc)**. thereafter up closing date. The maximum number of entries accepted for the meeting will be 413.

A surcharge of \$110 including GST applies to any entry which nominates for more than one category with the same driver. In these cases the driver must indicate on the entry form his/hers first and second choice of which category they would like to run. A separate full entry fee is payable if the cross entry is for the same vehicle but with a different driver. A separate full entry fee is also payable if a driver enters more than one category with a different vehicle. Individual entry forms must be completed by each car and driver.

All drivers must be current financial members of CAMS affiliated clubs and hold a PCC,PC,CC, NC, ICC or other type of licence as approved for racing events by CAMS.

Competition Numbers will be allocated according to the categories allocated numbers which have been supplied to the series by the Category Administrators. Numbers will otherwise be allocated at the promoters discretion to best fit with category allocations and competitors wishes as much as is possible.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event.

Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.

Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the CAMS Manual.

The promoter reserves the right to cancel, postpone or abandon the event in accordance with NCR59.

Timing will be electronic and each competitor will require a Dorian Transmitter, fitted in accordance with category provisions and in the left or right foot well of sedan based vehicles.

ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

FUEL REQUIREMENTS

NOISE

Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with the 95 dB noise limit

TARGETED SCRUTINY

Targeted Scrutiny procedures will apply. Vehicle Logbooks will be checked by scrutineers to confirm which vehicles are due for audit; and if required, suitable arrangements will be made. Please note that this does not mean your car will not be subject to scrutiny throughout the weekend. Drivers will be required to present upon request their current CAMS licence, CAMS affiliated car club membership, and vehicle logbook (if issued).

All driver apparel shall comply with Schedule D of the 2017 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and is also subject to targeted Scrutiny.

RISK WARNING, DISCLAIMER AND INDEMNITY

Motor Sport Activities are inherently dangerous recreational activities and there is significant risk of injury, disability or death. If you do not wish to be exposed to such risks, then you should not participate in the Motor Sport Activities.

I acknowledge that:

- the risks associated with attending or participating in Motor Sport Activities include but are NOT LIMITED to the risk that I may suffer harm as a result of:
 - motor vehicles (or parts of them) colliding with other motor vehicles or persons or property;
 - others participants acting dangerously or with lack of skills;
 - high levels of noise exposure;
 - acts of violence and other harmful acts (whether intentional or inadvertent) committed by persons attending or participating in the event; and
 - the failure or unsuitability of facilities (including grand-stands, fences and guard rails) to ensure my safety.

EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY, RELEASE & INDEMNITY

In exchange for being able to attend or participate in the Motor Sport Activities, I agree:

I understand that:

- nothing in this document excludes, restricts or modifies any rights that I may have as a result of significant personal injury that is caused by the Reckless Conduct of the Entities as the supplier of the Motor Sport Activities / Recreational Services;
- nothing in this document prevents the Entities from relying on any laws (including statute and common law) that limit or preclude their liability;
- nothing in this document excludes any term or guarantee which under statute cannot be excluded; however the liability of the Entities is limited to the minimum claimable amount payable.

- nothing in this document precludes me from making a claim under a CAMS insurance policy where I am expressly entitled to make a claim under that insurance policy; and
- CAMS has arranged some limited personal injury insurance coverage which may provide me with some protection for loss, damage or injury that I may suffer during my participation in the Motor Sport Activities.
