Supplementary Regulations

1. Authority

The Event will be held under the International Sporting Code of FIA, the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motorsport Limited (CAMS), the Race Meeting Standing Regulations, the 2018 Victorian State Circuit Racing Championships Series Regulations; when approved, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations or instructions that may be issued.

This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au. The CAMS Permit Number is: 318/0403/01.

2. Promoter and Organiser

4. Event Description

The Event will be held over three days. Friday 2 March 2017 will be Private Practice. Saturday 4 and Sunday 5 March 2017 will be a State Championship Race Meeting. The Event will be conducted at Sandown International Raceway, Melbourne and cars will circulate in an anticlockwise direction on the 3.1 km National Circuit.

5. Categories

Qualifying and Racing will be provided for the following categories: Formula Vee, Formula Ford, Formula Ford 1600, MG / Invited British Sports Cars, Sports Cars, HQ Holden, Improved Production / BMW E30, Sports Sedans, Saloon Cars, Historic Touring Cars, Porsche 944 Challenge, Hyundai Excel, and Formula Junior.

6. Entries

The preferred method of entry is via CAMS Event Entry – Go to www.cams.com.au, sign in then follow link to CAMS Event Entry. Those using it know it is easy and efficient. We strongly encourage you to use this time saving system. There is a tutorial on the website for first timers and a telephone help number for use during business hours.

Friday Practice entries close 10.00am 2 March 2018. The Entry Fee for Friday Practice is \$195.00 GST inc.

Saturday/Sunday race entries open 22 January 2018 and close 23 February 2018. "Early Bird" race Entry Fee received up to **16 February 2018** is \$410 GST inc. Thereafter until the closing date the race Entry Fee is \$440.00 GST inc. The maximum number of entries will be 356.

A \$110 GST inc. surcharge applies to any entry which nominates for more than one category with the same Driver. In these cases, the Driver must indicate on the Entry Form his/hers first and second category choices. A separate full Entry Fee is payable if the cross entry is for the same vehicle, but with a different Driver. A separate full Entry Fee is also payable if a Driver enters more than one category with a different vehicle.

All Drivers must be current financial members of CAMS affiliated clubs and hold a PCC, PC, CC, NC, ICC or other type of license as approved for racing events.

Preferred car numbers must be requested on the Entry Forms. These will be allocated on a first come first served basis, or if the categories have their own pre allocated numbers, then they will be used.

7. Garage Hire

There are Garages for hire. The Pit Lane Garages (cost \$230) measure 8.5 meters deep and permit only one car width across. You may share the Garage parking one car behind the other. There are also Single Garages (\$130) and Carports (\$100) along the rear fence of the Paddock. No deposit is required, but if your Garage is not left clean and tidy at the end of the Event, the Committee reserves the right to charge you a Cleaning Fee. Garages will be allocated on a first come first served basis. The Garage Form has details.

8. Series Regulations

Vehicle classes and eligibility can be found in the current *Victorian State Circuit Racing Championships Series Regulations* at www.vicstateraceseries.com.

9. General

- The Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without assigning any reason thereto, in accordance with the provisions of NCR 83.
- Protests must be in accordance with Part XII of the NCRs.
- Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.
- The Promoter reserves the right to cancel, postpone or abandon the event in accordance with NCR 59.
- Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise limit of 95 dB.
- Driver apparel shall be in accordance with Schedule D of the 2018 *CAMS Manual of Motor Sport*.
- Drivers will be required to present their current CAMS licence, CAMS affiliated car club membership, and vehicle logbook (if issued).
- Scrutiny on Saturday and Sunday will commence at 7:30am, with track activity beginning at 9:00am.
- The Chief Timekeeper and Clerk of the Course shall be Judge of Fact.

10. Targeted Scrutiny

Targeted Scrutiny procedures will apply all three days of the meeting to cars entered in races. Vehicle logbooks will be checked by Scrutineers to confirm which vehicles are due for audit, and if required, suitable arrangements will be made. If the vehicle is not due for examination, Scrutineers still have the right to conduct random audits during the Event.

11. Alcohol, Drugs And Other Substances

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

12. Final Regulations and Passes

Final Regulations and other documents will be emailed to you week commencing 26 February – **ensure your email address is on your Entry Form.**

Tender Passes and Tickets WILL NOT BE POSTED TO YOU. **When you arrive, COLLECT documents at the Credentials Tent in Racecourse Drive near entrance to Red Hill Viewing Area.**
